That curiosity and wonder is what gave me the strength to get back on my feet. Recovery took months, and it took me a while before I could even walk on my own.

So what did I do? I booked a trip to Acadia National Park. With nature cheering me on, I was bound and determined to get back out on the trails.

Nearly 9 months later, I found myself on the Ocean Path Trail at Acadia National Park. I have always loved hiking and being outdoors, but there was something special and different about that moment.

The sunshine, the waves, the beauty that surrounded me. It all made my heart sing. I needed to find a way to capture that magical moment.

My jewelry line was reborn. Each piece I create harnesses the beauty and joy of nature. They celebrate what we love, turning moments into tangible memories that we can keep close to our hearts.



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
